New FABER series of works

FABER is a new series of works from Stücheli Architekten and an invitation to explore architecture in a whole new way. At the beginning of each year, we give people the chance to take an artistic journey into one of our latest projects.

One rule of thumb is that it takes a generation for a newly-built district to transform into a vibrant part of a city. Individual buildings usually establish themselves in the minds of local residents within a year. With our latest series, FABER (a Latin term for something created by an artist or craftsman), we are no longer waiting for life to come to our buildings, but are pre-emptively bringing life to them. The concept is simple: each year, we invite artists to use their vision to enrich one of our latest works. FABER 01 is dedicated to the new Ambassador House, which was converted at the end of 2017. In this 'great house,' author Ralf Schlatter created the story of a 'small man': *Fräulein Schwarz und das Meer* (Miss Black and the Sea).
