## Lingo Café - EF Education First, Zurich







The spatial backbone of the tapered interior is defined by a blue-tiled bar counter and a central wooden volume. Clad in solid oak moldings, the monolithic structure is articulated with subtle detailing, transforming it into an elegant, space-defining piece of furniture. Discreetly integrated within are a compact kitchen, a restroom, built-in appliances, and storage units that extend all the way to the ceiling efficiently concealed from view. At the rear of the café, a secondary counter is thoughtfully positioned, inviting guests to linger and observe the rhythms of the street through a distinctive round window.

The southern corner of the building follows a symmetrical design and is mirrored by an adjacent room of identical geometry, available for seminars or small events. This space is defined by a timber-clad rear wall, a stone floor, and an exposed concrete ceiling—material elements that echo those of the café, forming a cohesive spatial ensemble around the central passageway. Outfitted with a large screen facing the street, the seminar room doubles as a secondary showcase for the language school.
